Matt O'Connor & Bruichladdich Whisky

Built in 1881 by the Harvey brothers, Bruichladdich distillery sits opposite the western shore of Loch Indaal on Islay, an island off the west coast of Scotland. The distillery produces three distinct single malts: Bruichladdich (unpeated), Port Charlotte (heavily peated) and Octomore (super heavily peated)”

Blood and Sand

Named for the 1920's Rudolph Valentino film, this often forgotten whisky classic is a pleasure to sip on chilly nights. Bruichladdich, Cherry Heering and Punt E Mes shaken with hand squeezed orange juice, served straight up.

Smokey Bramble

Dick Bradsell's legendary drink twisted out with smoky Islay Scotch. Port Charlotte swizzled with fresh lemon juice and sugar then treated with a cherry Heering float, served long on crushed ice.

Churchill's Favourite

“Always remember that I have taken more out of alcohol than alcohol has taken out of me” Bruichladdich stirred with Italian Vermouth and Cointreau. Served up with an orange twist.
